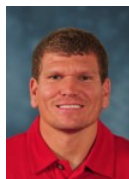

College Prep Residential Camps for Boys | Ages 15-18 | \$425

1st Session: July 18, 19 & 20, Check In: 1 pm. July 18 | Check Out: 12 PM. July 20

2nd Session: August 1, 2, & 3, Check In: 1 pm. August 1 | Check Out: 12P M. August 3

Instruction provided by Active/Former Professional Players and College Coaches for the serious soccer player who has a strong interest to play at the college level. This session emphasizes proper technical skills building the necessary foundation for advanced play. Tactical group concepts will be implemented or introduced based upon camper skill level. Our staff will cover many topics within the curriculum: principles of attacking and defending, combination play, pressure-cover-balance, flank play, counter attacking, zonal defending, finishing, and match play analysis.

High School Prep Residential Camp for Boys | Ages 12-14 | \$425

Residential Camp: July 20, 21 & 22, Check In: 1 pm. July 20 | Check Out: 12 PM. July 22

This camp will focus on preparing players for high school and getting early exposure to the Division I College training environment. This camp will cover all the fundamentals skills required to play at a high level. The daily curriculum will consist of individual skills development, tactical drills, fitness training, small-sided and full-sided match play.

High School Team Residential Camp for Boys | Ages 15-18 | \$425

Residential Camp: August 3, 4, & 5, Check In: 1 pm. August 3 | Check Out: 12 PM. August 5

Perfect for any high school or club team who wants to get a jump start on their upcoming season. This session emphasizes proper technical skills, building the necessary foundation for advanced team play. Tactical Team concepts will be implemented or introduced based upon the team skill level. Our staff will also cover many tactical topics within the curriculum: principles of attacking and defending, roles and responsibilities of formations, combination play, pressure-cover-balance, flank play, counter attacking, zonal defending, finishing, and match play analysis.

Youth Camps for Boys & Girls | Ages 6-14 | \$125

Dates & Locations will be announced shortly. This particular camp is hosted at selected sites off of SJU campus.

Instruction provided by SJU Staff Coaches and other College Coaches emphasizing the importance of technique through individual skills and small sided play. Campers will learn the proper fundamentals in a structured training environment. The camp curriculum will progress from repetition drills with no pressure to more difficult game situations with defensive pressure. We want the campers to have fun, however, the main focus is teaching the individual skills and techniques needed to become better soccer players.
